



Subject	POLICY ON REGISTRATION OF VESSELS.
To	ALL SHIPOWNERS, MANAGERS, OPERATORS, MASTERS, AUTHORIZED SPECIAL AGENTS (ASA), AND RECOGNIZED ORGANIZATIONS

Marine Circular

1. APPLICABILITY:

This Marine Circular is applicable to all the vessels applying for the registration under the flag of Nicaragua.

2. TERMS OF ACCEPTANCE OF VESSEL:

2.1 For Vessel Below 25 Years of Age

Survey Report	Detention if any	RO/Statutory Certificates	Crew Certificate Endorsement
PostProvisional Registration	No 2 or more in a calendar Year & No Detention History in Last 3 Month	Within 15 days from the date of Provisional Registration or before departure from Immediate Port of Call, whichever comes earlier.	Within 15 days from the date of Provisional Registration before departure from Immediate Port of Call, whichever comes earlier.

2.2 For Vessel Above 25 years of Age

Survey Report	Detention if any	RO/Statutory Certificates	Crew Certificate Endorsement
PreProvisional Registration	No 2 or more in a calendar Year & No Detention History in Last 3 Month	Within 15 days from the date of Provisional Registration or before departure from Immediate Port of Call, whichever comes earlier.	Within 15 days from the date of Provisional Registration or before departure from Immediate Port of Call, whichever comes earlier.

2.3 Vessel under Single Delivery and Demolition Voyage

Survey Report	RO/Statutory Certificates	Crew Certificate Endorsement
PreProvisional Registration (in case of Vessel is under Tow, the towing vessel Seaworthiness certificate must be submitted)	Within 7 days from the date of Provisional Registration or before departure from Immediate Port of Call, whichever comes earlier.	Within 7 days from the date of Provisional Registration or before departure from Immediate Port of Call, whichever comes earlier.

This administration reserves all the rights of rejection of registering any vessel, without any further details whatsoever, and this administration is not liable for any refunds etc. whatsoever, in case the vessel is not accepted to be registered by this administration.

In case of deregistration, the owners remain liable for applicable deletion fees and annual taxes until deletion certificate is issued.
